## **A Teacher**

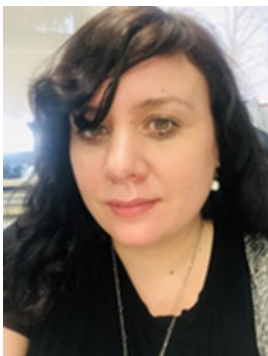

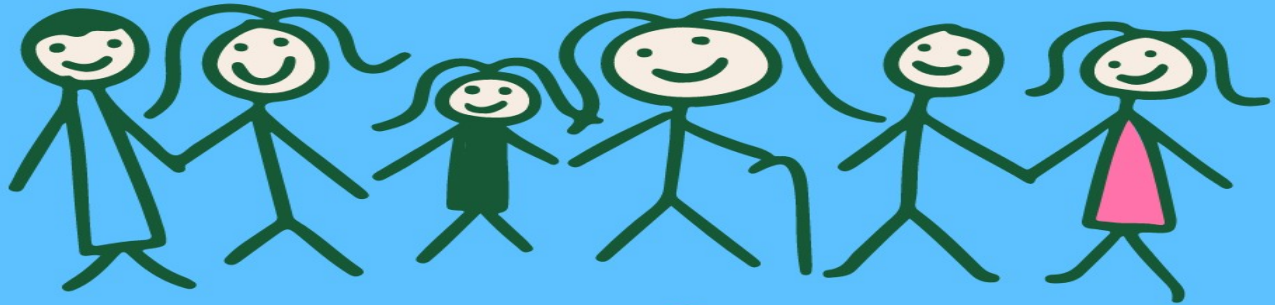

## Before & After School Program (K-Grade 5)

### 2021-2022 School Year

#### Program Plan

Children enrolled in the program can expect a safe, enjoyable experience with staff before and after the school day. Students will be given a snack in the morning and after school as well as play based programming for their stay. Students may also have the opportunity to do crafts and be read to from time to time. Students will primarily be situated in one of our unused classrooms but may also spend time in the gym or outside when possible.

Morning 7:30am – 8:30am, when the school staff begins supervision

Afternoon 3:30pm – 5:30pm

\*The program will be not be available on PLC Days, school breaks, conventions or statutory holidays.
