Thank you for continuing to share your children with us this year, as a staff we take a lot of pride in providing educational experiences that are well suited to every learner at Red Wing, and that is no easy task! Our staff will continue to put a focus on Math skills and overall literacy throughout this year as we would to achieve our school goal for the year. That goal is as follows:

By June 2022 100% of our students will be achieving:

- · exemplary and meeting standards or
- 50% catch up growth or
- an individualized goal.

Goals related to "50% catch up" and "individualized" means that we recognize that not all students are able to achieve grade level standing by the end of the current year so we adjust their goals to suit a reasonable de-

gree of growth. These goals are monitored and reviewed throughout the year, sometimes they are adjusted down and at other times they are adjusted up to suit the growth of the student.

We will have our first set of Parent Conferences on November 4th this year. In a year where SRPSD has moved to providing 2 report cards per year these Conferences are vital in providing an opportunity for parents/guardians and teachers to connect on student performance to this point in the school year. Keep in mind if you would rather speak with your child's teachers virtually you are welcome to communicate your request using the survey form which was sent out in October. If you are still wishing to request a conference either by phone or video conference please use link on this page or call the office to let us know. With our first formal report card not coming home until January 28th we feel the time is right for us to launch our parent connection to Edsby.



Edsby is the online platform the teachers have been using for assessment recording and the school has been using to record attendance so far this year. Edsby is a diverse online tool that we are ready to share with parents so that they can follow the progress of their child(ren) online. Edsby will allow parents to see the assess-

ment scores for their children in real time as they are entered by the teachers. Parents can set notifications for when the scores are posted or just check in on them from time to time as they like. Edsby will also allow the office a more efficient and reliable way to communicate with our families. It will use the email addresses provided on registration forms so please check with the office if you are not receiving any notifications from us via email and we can work together to diagnose the issue.

Our plan is to launch Edsby on November 3rd so please keep an eye out for our invitation email. Anyone experiencing difficulties getting connected is welcome to call or email the office. Mr. McGregor will also be available to answer Edsby questions on Parent Conference night, November 4th.




