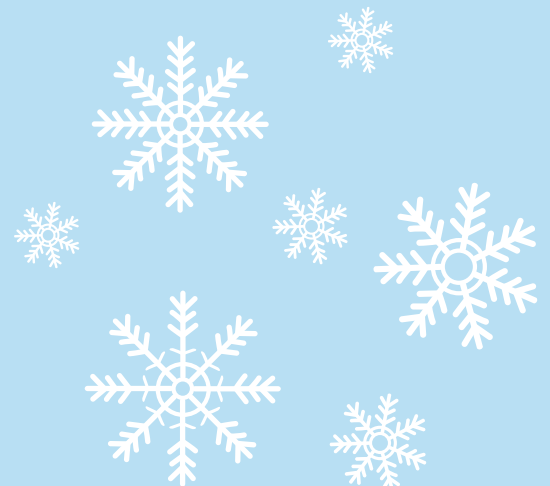

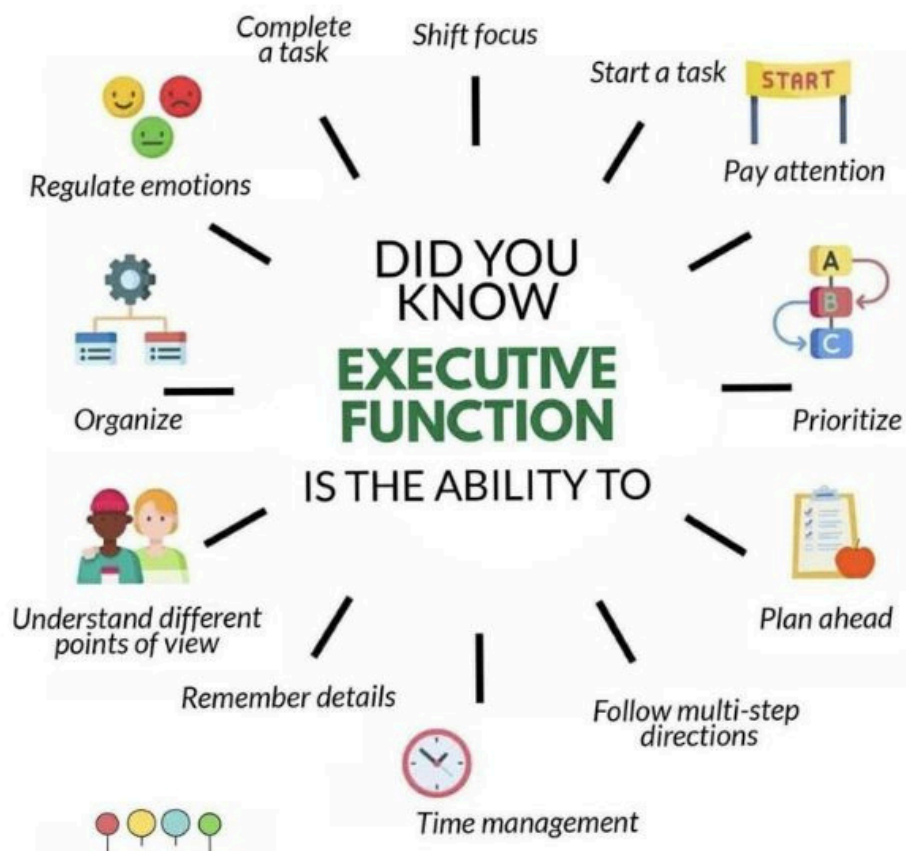


# Our new Student Engagement Center
