Red Wing Public School Vision


Our school shares a vision of success for all students.

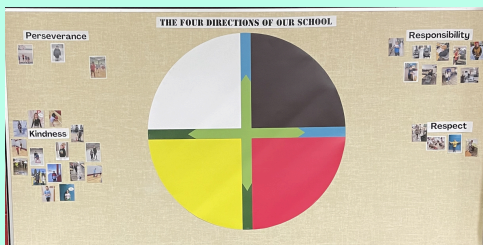

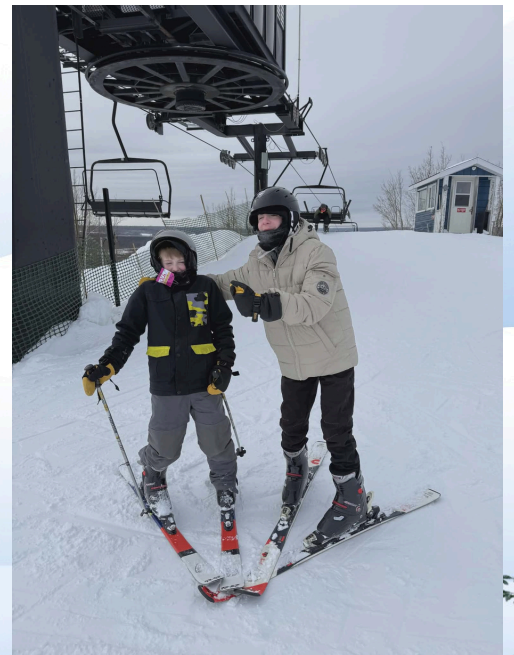
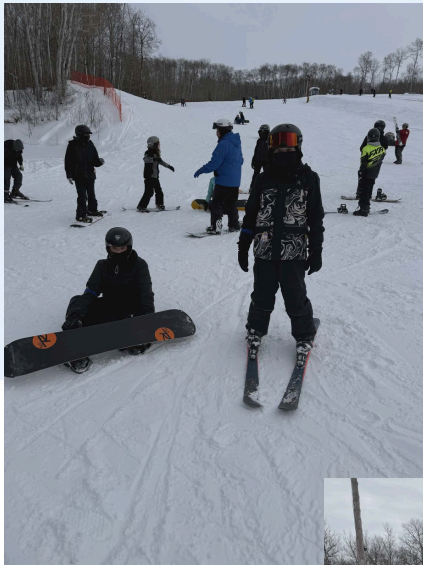
